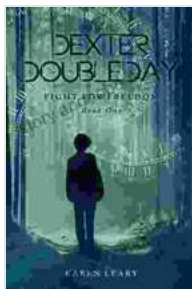


# Dexter Doubleday: A Fight for Freedom

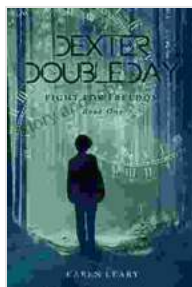
